## Crisis Intervention Team Training (CIT)

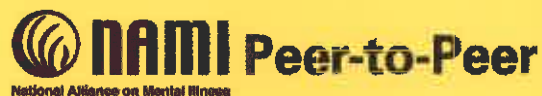
A 40-hour week training for law enforcement officers on how to respond to persons with mental illness in crisis.

Peer-to-Peer is a unique, experiential learning program for people with any serious mental illness who are interested in establishing and maintaining their wellness and recovery. A free 10-week course for individuals with a mental illness taught by trained peers.

is the new signature education program for parents and other caregivers of children and adolescents living with mental illnesses. It is taught by trained teachers who are the parent or other caregivers of individuals who developed the symptoms of mental illness prior to the age of 13 years.
