Questions and Follow Ups:

1. Do GCs have to add in allowances to their bid submissions?
 - a. PSO will add after the fact. The allowances are prefilled in on the bid sheet (P131/BP3 of Solicitation). Purchasing will post the fillable Bid Sheet form to Demandstar and PSO website.
2. Has a private provider been identified already?
 - a. We do not have a private provider identified. We will work with the general contractor to identify.
3. How do we find all the posted Q and A for this RFQ?
 - a. All information related to RFQ 2FY20 can be found on www.demandstar.com or you can visit <https://pascosheriff.com/index.html>. Once you are on the page, click on citizen resources, then you will choose resources in the drop down. Once you've clicked on resources it will take you to the page with 4 horizontal tabs, you will choose vendor resources and there if you scroll down you will find all of our current RFQ information.
4. What is the award date of the contract?
 - a. Intent to Award is August 1st, 2020
5. Are there wage requirements?
 - a. Wage requirements are not called out for this RFQ.
6. Are site visits allowed?
 - a. Yes, site visits are allowed any time. The location of the construction site will be off Central Boulevard / Lucy Dobies Court in Land O Lakes, FL 34637.

7. These buildings may be built all at once or individually based on available funding. Pricing is different based on each option. How would you like GC's to indicate such?
 - a. Contractors can submit costs for all 3 buildings together and also cost per building separately. We will update the bid form to allow for this option. The updated bid form will be posted as indicated in #1/#3.
8. Is this pre-bid conference mandatory?
 - a. No. The conference was not mandatory.
9. Is there power and water at the construction site?
 - a. Yes, there will be power and water at the time of construction
10. Is there an absolute date that construction must be completed by?
 - a. At this time there is not a set date. The construction timeline will be determined amongst PSO and selected bidder.
11. Is the general contractor responsible for the permit costs?
 - a. PSO will cover costs of permits. Inspections are part of the allowance. If an inspection fails as a result of something under the control of the GC, PSO will not cover any additional costs incurred due to re-inspection.
12. Is there a cost associated with the badging process?
 - a. There is no cost to the general contractor to have access to the site.

14. Clarification on the dimensions for the main building is 5'0 x 80' as indicated in the construction documents, not the specifications attachment in the solicitation. Please refer to the information in the construction documents.
