

Q1. Does the County presently have a body camera system? If so, which system, who is the Manufacturer, and when was the system purchased and installed?

**The Pasco Sheriff's Office is currently using the Axon body worn cameras. The BWC program started in December 2014.**

Q2. How many locations does the County anticipate for the uploading/downloading of body camera video?

**Currently we have three (3) district offices which each have one 6-bay docking station installed at the read-off room. Each member assigned a body worn camera is issued a single-bay docking station to be used at their residence.**

Q3. How many sworn officers does the County have?

**Approximately 800 sworn officers**

Q4. Will the County clarify if it has a preferred project start date and/or completion date, and any other important milestone dates for the transition plan and deployment?

**The current contract with Axon expires on 18 Dec 2019. We require the start date to be 19 Dec 2019 so there is no lapse in BWC coverage. A plan will be in place to complete a transition of equipment.**

Q5. Does the County presently have an in-car camera system? If so, which system, who is the Manufacturer, and when was the system purchased and installed?

**The Pasco Sheriff's Office is currently using the Watchguard 4RE in car system in six (6) Traffic Unit vehicles. Purchased date is in 2016.**

Q6. How many marked patrol cars does the County have?

**Approximately 370-400 marked units.**

Q7. On page 13 of the RFQ, the Quote form asks under Section 'B. Quote Pricing' for Vendors to provide the Total Cost Year 1, Total Cost Year 2, and Total Cost Year 3. Would the County clarify if Vendors should assume a total quantity of 475 body worn cameras units?

**Please provide a quote for 3 and 5 years.**

**For a five year contract, the Pasco Sheriff's Office is also asking the vendor to break down the per year cost of the total contract for the total quantity of body camera units purchased (475).**

Q8. Would the County consider a 5 year term of contract, since such an extension in term would make additional discounts feasible?

**The Pasco Sheriff's Office is looking at a 3 or 5 year contract.**

Q9. On page 13 of the RFQ, the Quote form asks under Section 'B. Quote Pricing' for Vendors to provide the Total Cost Year 1, Total Cost Year 2, and Total Cost Year 3. Would the County clarify if Vendors may offer pricing options for Total Cost Year 4, and Total Cost Year 5?

**The Pasco Sheriff's Office is requesting the vendor to provide a breakdown per year for 3 and 5 year contract.**
