

Privacy Policy

This website and related subdomains are provided by the Pasco Sheriff's Office (PSO) as a public service. Be advised that information you submit to the PSO via this website may be considered a public record under the laws of the State of Florida and may be subject to disclosure pursuant to a Public Records Request.

Information Collected

If you visit our site(s) to read or download information, we automatically collect and store the following information about your visit:

1. The name of the domain (for example, "xcompany.com" if you use a private Internet access account or "yourschool.edu" if you are connecting from a university's domain) and IP address (a number that is automatically assigned to your computer when you are using the Internet) from which you access our website;
2. The type of browser and operating system used to access our site;
3. The date and time you access our site;
4. The Internet address of the website from which you linked directly to our site; and
5. The pages you visit on our site.

We may set and access "cookies" on your computer. A cookie is a small amount of data which often includes an anonymous unique identifier that is sent to your browser from a web site's computer and stored on your computer's hard drive. You may configure your browser to accept all cookies, reject all cookies, or notify you when a cookie is set. Each browser is different. This information is primarily collected for statistical analysis. Online Forms Submissions

PSO may ask visitors who request certain specific information to fill out an online form. For example, if you are applying for employment by using an online form, you will be asked to provide your name, address and other personal data. From time to time, other information may be collected through questionnaires, feedback forms or other means that enable us to determine a user's interests and needs, help us improve our web site, or for other purposes.

Information Sharing

We may share personally identifying information (PII) with PSO departments and personnel, other law enforcement or government agencies, other third parties in the course of carrying out our normal business operations and in accordance with Florida law. We may disclose information about inmates, wanted suspects, missing persons, etc. as required in the normal course of our duties. We do not rent or sell personal information about users.

The PSO participates on open, unmoderated forums offered by commercial social networks sites in order to increase law enforcement transparency, promote public participation, and encourage collaboration. We currently maintain official PSO accounts on Facebook, YouTube, and Twitter.
